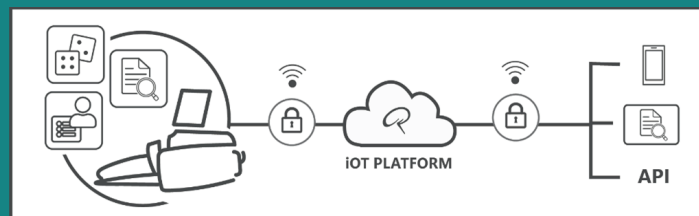
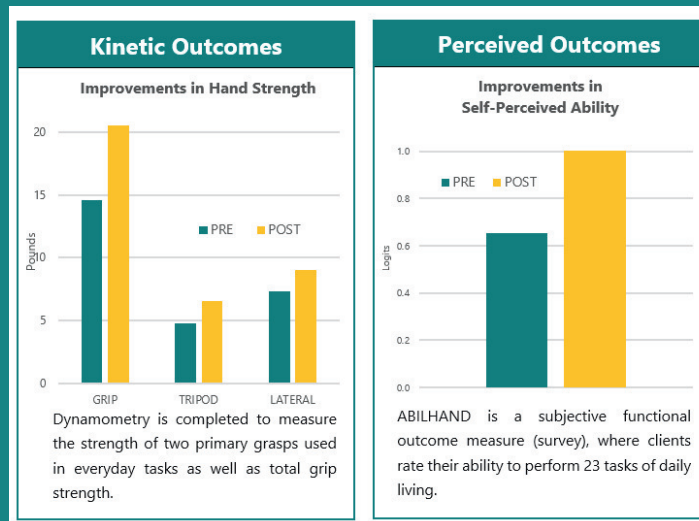
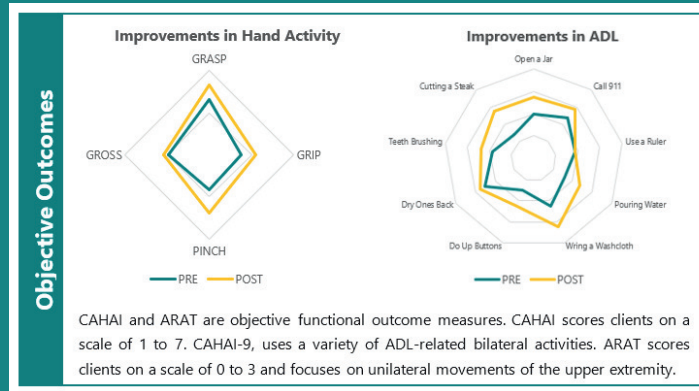
The MyHand® System leverages the brain's neurophysiological mechanisms to 'reprogram' damaged neural pathways. By engaging the human sensory system (touch, pressure, and proprioception sensation) and motor apparatus (hand and forearm muscles), it helps develop alternative neural pathways.

Therapy can be delivered in person at a clinic through the mechatronic device and, in a future update, via remote virtual rehabilitation, allowing patients to receive therapy at home with tele-rehabilitation guidance from professionals.
